





Mary Pearson

Marv Pearson received his Bachelor of Science degree in 1955 from the University of Minnesota - Duluth and his Masters degree from the University of Northern Colorado in 1965. He taught in Northern Wisconsin from 1955 - 1959. Marv returned to Minnesota and taught for the St. Cloud School District from 1959 - 1990, serving as Director of Bands at Tech High School from 1970 on. Marv joined the St. Cloud Municipal Band in 1959 when he returned to Minnesota and he served as its director from 1975 -1982. In 1984, Marv became one of the first directors of the SCACHSMB. He wishes to thank the SCMB for organizing the special 125th Anniversary concert and inviting him back to be one of the guest conductors.



Lowell Larson

Lowell Larson received his Bachelor of Science degree from Bemidji State University in Music Education in 1979. He taught instrumental music grades 5-12 in the Royalton, MN school district for seven years. While at Annandale, he went to graduate school at St Cloud State University and received his Master's degree in Music Education in 1989. He is now in his 27th year of teaching at Annandale.
